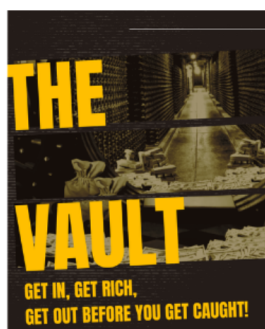
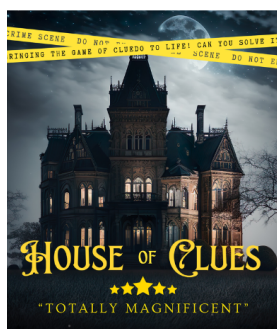

This unusual National Trust property is filled with handcrafted decorations, travel mementoes, and architectural curiosities, including a shell-encrusted gallery with nearly 25,000 shells and a delicate feather frieze made from native birds.

Visitors can explore rooms filled with bespoke furniture designed to suit the house's unique geometry, stroll through the peaceful orchard and wildflower meadow with views over the Exe Estuary, and enjoy refreshments from the on-site trailer. A second-hand bookshop and sculpture trail add to the charm of the visit.

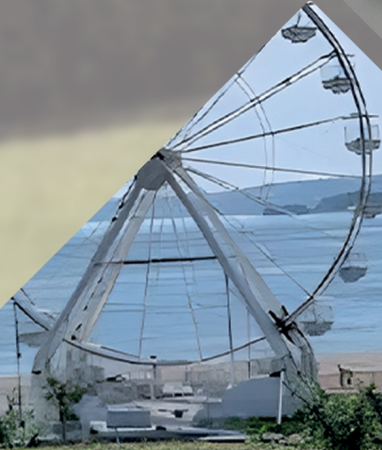

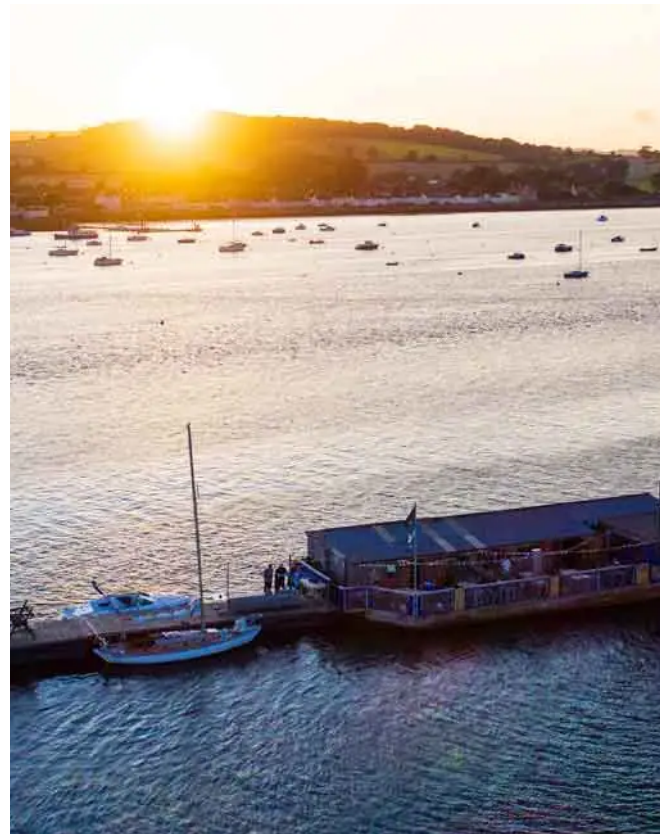
River Exe Café

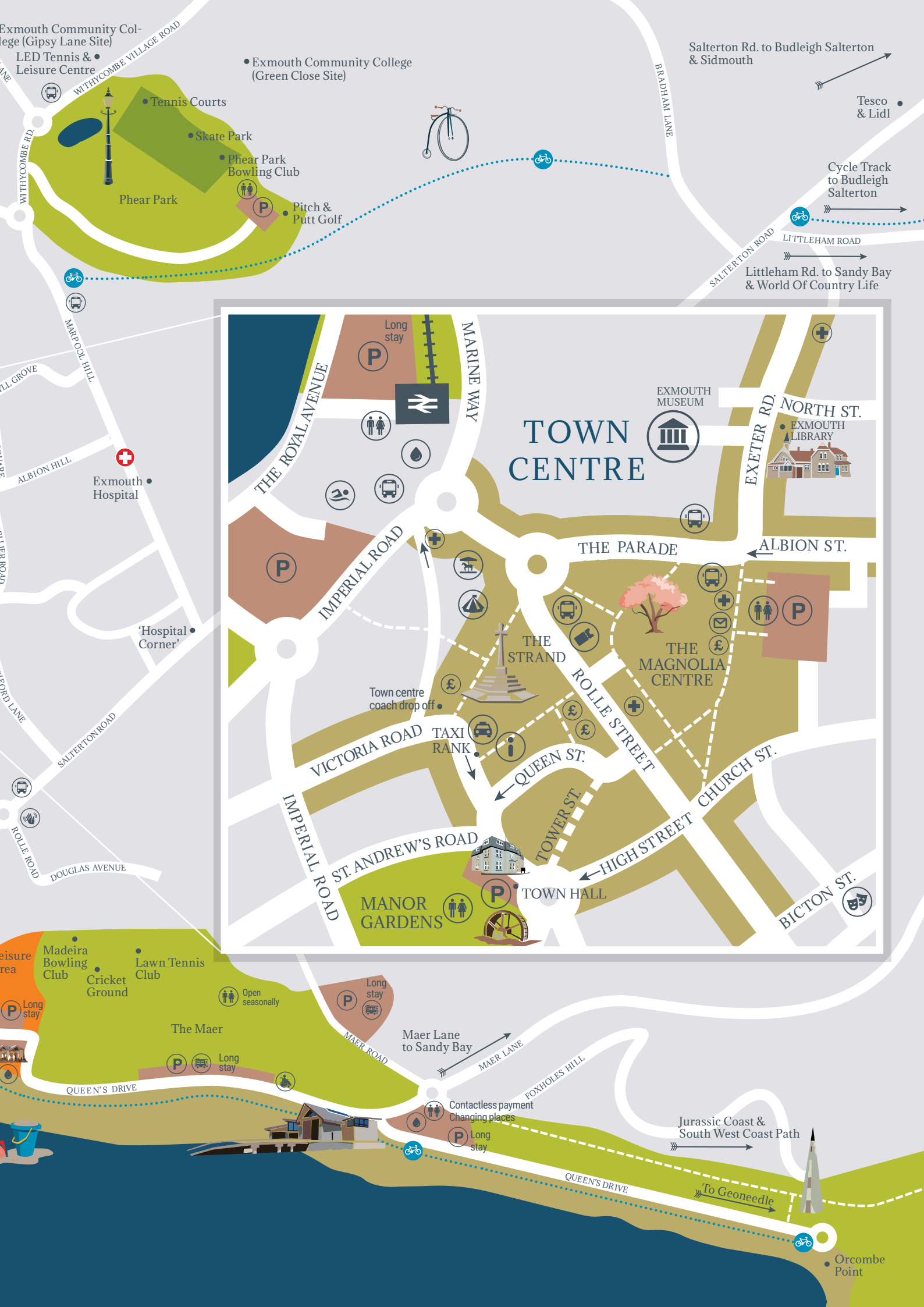

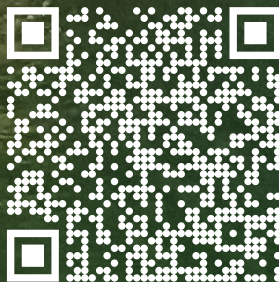
