MORNING:

EXMOUTH WALKING TOURS

Begin your day with a guided walk through Exmouth's historic streets. Discover local stories, hidden gems, and the people who shaped the town's character.

EXMOUTH MUSEUM

Continue your journey into the past at Exmouth Museum, where you'll learn about the town's maritime history, social heritage, and longstanding seaside traditions.

LUNCH:

OTTERTON MILL

Head to this beautifully restored working mill—one of the oldest in Britain—for artisan food made with local ingredients. Explore the craft shop and watch the mill in action for a true heritage experience.



AFTERNOON:

A LA RONDE (NATIONAL TRUST)

Visit one of Devon's most unusual historic houses: a quirky 18th-century, 16-sided home built by cousins Jane and Mary Parminter after their Grand Tour of Europe.

Inside, you'll discover fascinating handcrafted interiors and curious collections, including intricate shell and feather decorations that reflect the sisters' creativity and adventurous spirit.

Wander through the rooms and then enjoy the orchard, meadow and peaceful grounds with lovely views across the Exe Estuary—an inspiring blend of architecture, history and landscape.

EVENING:

SAVEUR (SMALL GROUPS)

Perfect for intimate groups of up to 20, Saveur offers refined, French-inspired dining in a warm and elegant setting.
